Associate/Assistant Professor: An Associate/Assistant Professor is needed in the area of social policy or macro practice with specialized knowledge and expertise in Mental Health with an emphasis in Behavioral Health/Dual Diagnosis. Teaching experience at the doctoral and graduate level is also desired. The successful candidates will have a solid history of extramural funding and publications in the Mental Health field. A Ph.D. in social work or related field is required. An MSW is preferred but not necessary. A commitment to working in a multi-cultural environment with students of a diverse background is desired.

Assistant Professor: An Assistant Professor is needed in the area of human growth and behavior with specialized knowledge and expertise in Gerontology with an emphasis in Behavioral Health and Substance Abuse. Teaching experience at the graduate or undergraduate levels desired. The successful candidate will have a history of scholarly publications and extramural funding. A Ph.D. in Social Work or related field is required. An MSW is preferred but not necessary. A commitment to working in a multi-cultural environment with students of a diverse background is desired.

Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience. Application review will begin October 2007, and will continue until the search is completed.
