INTERNSHIPS: Duals complete 2 years of social work internship/field placements in Y2 & Y3.

Duals are welcome to also complete a PH HMP field placement (usually over the summer; but it is not required).

Duals are encouraged to participate in all HMP Professional Development Events through PH 798 (not required).

Dual students can only participate in the HMP Professional Development Series' Mock Interview session one time, and must contact the HMP Division Head in advance during the selected Spring semester.

THESIS: Duals must complete a thesis with 3-person committees comprised of T/TT PH & SW faculty. There is a 3-semester research sequence starting in Y2. The heavier course load in the 1st semester Fall allows for more internship and thesis time during Y2 and Y3.

***You are required to take both PH 797 and SW 797. The first 797 Research course (2nd Year Spring) alternates between PH and SW; then you enroll in the other 797 for the following 3rd Year Fall term.
