1. SDSU Campus Open

When an agency is closed for a holiday and SDSU Campus is open for this holiday, e.g. Indigenous Peoples' Day, President's Day, etc. and the student has scheduled internship hours on the day the agency is closed, the **student is responsible for making-up those hours** some time during the semester to meet the required curriculum hours in the practicum course.

2. SDSU Campus Closed

When the SDSU campus is closed, the student **cannot conduct internship hours on that day** even if the agency is open, such as on Veteran's Day or the Friday after the Thanksgiving Holiday. If the student has scheduled internship hours on that day, the **student is responsible for making up those hours** to meet the required curriculum hours in the practicum course.

Students who are at their practicum during the Winter Break do so on a **voluntary basis**. A student's hours volunteered during this time frame **cannot** be applied towards required practicum course hours. We request that students be given a **minimum of two consecutive weeks off** during the Winter Break. If students do volunteer their time for continuity of client care during the academic break, a modified schedule is usually worked out with their Agency/Field Instructor, for example, instead of the student attending for the full 16 or 20 hours, they may reduce their hours to only 10 hours per week.

Students are covered by the University's liability insurance during academic breaks, but **cannot be at their practicum when campus is closed during Winter Break, December 23 – 26, 2025, New Year's Day, observed on Jan. 1, 2026, and MLK Jr. Day, Jan. 19, 2026. Campus will also be closed on Cesar Chavez Day (March 31, 2026) during Spring Break and therefore students cannot be at their practicum.**
