The City Heights Master of Social Work (MSW) Scholarship is a collaboration between the SDSU School of Social Work and Price Philanthropies. It was created in response to the growing need to support a bilingual, culturally responsive social work workforce. This scholarship will provide support services and tuition assistance to two students for two years in the MSW direct practice concentration, who have experience living and/or working in City Heights, qualify for financial assistance, and are passionate about serving the City Heights community.



Eligible candidates must:

- Have a Bachelor's degree in social work or a related field
- Apply to the full-time direct practice concentration of SDSU's 2-year MSW Program and be enrolled for the 2020-2021 academic year (application period open 10/1/2019-12/15/2019)
- Submit a sponsorship letter from a City Heights organization and letters of recommendation
- Take the GRE and have a minimum 3.0 undergraduate cumulative GPA

- Have an interest in becoming a Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) who can serve the diverse needs of the City Heights community
- Preferred candidates will be bilingual with demonstrated proficiency in one or more languages such as: Somali, Burmese, Khmer, Vietnamese, Arabic or Amharic
